BEWARE: It's TICK season again!

Summer is the most prominent time for the paralysis tick. The tick attaches to dogs and cats as they brush past foliage in bush land, near creeks or even in your own back yard. They are particularly evident on warm days when it has rained previously. Once they attach at a suitable site they begin to engorge with blood and after adequate feeding will start injecting a potent toxin, which will paralyse and eventually kill your pet if not removed.

WHAT TO DO: Prevention is always the best option. Ticks are so small and it is almost impossible to spot them on your pet before it is too late. Make sure you are treating your pet with a tick prevention product such as Frontline Plus or Advantix once a fortnight. Make sure you think about tick prevention before you leave your pets at home to go on your holiday. Speak to your pet sitter about tick prevention, they are more than happy to keep your routine while you are away.
