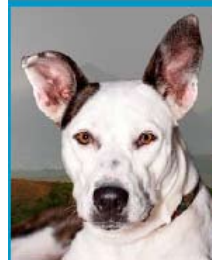

"Rover All Over" Program, which takes dogs into public places enabling people to see firsthand how great shelter animals are, successfully helping to re-home over 100 dogs since its inception in July this year.

A life-saving Behaviour Intervention Program, whereby Animal Rehabilitation Trainers work closely with Foster Parents to provide tailored training to "special need" dogs, successfully training around 200 dogs this year alone.

A Community Outreach Adoption Program, which takes small animals available for adoption into public places providing more locations for animals to be adopted, successfully rehoming over 350 animals since its inception in the past twelve months.

Combined, these programs have enabled over 650 more animals to find their "forever" homes had they not been implemented. As we approach the warmer weather and the increase in incoming animals it brings, the need for these programs has become critical.
